Implementation

IIRSA Project Portfolio

- To continue the updating of the IIRSA Project Portfolio Database.
- To create GTEs of the 9 Integration and Development Hubs in order to allow the exchange among the countries in each Hub regarding the performance and eventual incorporation of projects.

Implementation Agenda Based on Consensus (AIC, in Spanish, 2005-2010)

- Elaboration of a Report on the Implementation Agenda Based on Consensus (AIC 1). Said report must mention the status of the projects, as well as an assessment of the portfolio and the contributions for the AIC 2.
- To define and approve the "AIC 2" (the projects must not be isolated, but within an integration logics).



Planning

Ordering of the Portfolio

- To revise the projects of the following Hubs: Paraguay-Paraná Waterway, Capricorn and MERCOSUR-Chile, by virtue of the discussions that were carried out in 2009
- To continue the works in order to create the Southern Andean Hub

Environmental and Social Assessment Methodology with Strategic Approach (Metodología de Evaluación Ambiental y Social con Enfoque Estratégico – EASE, in Spanish)

 To apply the methodology in the groups prioritized by the countries: G6 of the Amazon and G2 of the Southern Hub.



Planning

Productive Integration and Logistics Methodology (Metodología de Integración Productiva y Logística –IPrLg, in Spanish)

To continue the application of the methodology in the Group 5 of the Andean Hub and apply it to the Group 4 of the MERCOSUR-Chile Hub.

Training in the Integration Process

- To carry out courses/workshops on Development and Physical Integration in South America, which may include the following modules (among others):
 - Module of Training related to the Environmental and Social Assessment Methodology with Strategic Approach (EASE, in Spanish) and the results of its application;
 - Module of Training related to Productive Integration and Logistics Methodology (IPrLg, in Spanish) and the results of its application

Facilitation of Border Crossings – Border Integration

 To carry out a Workshop on Border Crossings and Border Integration in order to present and discuss the progress and results of the studies performed within the framework of the IIRSA.

South American Roaming

- Begin the implementation of the Action Plan for the South American Roaming Project that was presented during the GTE on ICTs held in Cusco in May 2009
- The implementation will consist of two phases, the first of which includes the following activities to be carried out in 2010:
 - Information standardization
 - Studies on double taxation
 - NRTRDE (Near Real-Time Roaming Data Exchange)
 - Implementation of GRQ (Global Roaming Quality)
 - Inadvertent Border Roaming
 - Creation of local border roaming area

Exports through Postal Services for PYMES

- GTE in order to analyze the progress and status related to the implementation of the project in the different countries
- Second seminar of the project for the Mesoamerican countries
- Third training round for multipliers/consultants of the project.
- Implantation of the project: continuation of the works in the corresponding countries.



Outreach

Activities

- To extend the actions devoted to the outreach and participation of the Initiative to the interior of each country (said actions are the ones promoted by these countries). The CCT will support these activities.
- To update the document of the 2010 IIRSA Project Portfolio.
- To elaborate the document "Ten Years of the IIRSA", with a summary of the progress of the physical integration process in South America.
- To prepare 3 new video documentaries. One of them should be on the "Ten Years of the IIRSA".
- To support outreaching actions in the countries regarding the "Ten Years of the IIRSA"

Sustainable Infrastructure

• To start a cycle of debates that allows the creation of consensus related to the use of a new paradigm for the integration infrastructure projects: the strength-idea of "sustainable infrastructures".

The idea of *"sustainable infrastructures"* implies an association (that begins from the planning phase) of projects related to transportation, energy and communications, with actions that boost vectors of economic, social and environmental development, combining infrastructure with logistics chains, integration of productive chains and socio-environmental and institutional aspects and their funding mechanisms.
