The approach of the SIGE

1. High quality, in-time information

- to generate useful information for the decision-making process in order to solve implementation problems.
- to create a memory of the project cycle life (planning and execution of the projects).
- to generate a **cooperation and commitment environment** regarding the implementation of the projects.



The approach of the SIGE

2.Monitoring aimed at decision

- The objective is not to continue the execution of the project, but to identify obstacles related to the implementation and their solution.
- To articulate and **give rise to the decisions** that are necessary to overcome restrictions.
- To evaluate the progress of the project.
 - To spread sound information on the progress of the project for the authorities and interested parties.



The approach of the SIGE

3. Communication

- To consolidate and spread information on the progress of the projects and their restrictions for a certain group of authorities in each country and the executives of the agencies (CCT).
- To generate **information in order to widely spread** data on the implementation of the projects.

SIGE - Improvements

- Forum: a new tool is available: "discussion forum" to foster interaction and to exchange experiences and important information for a better performance of the projects.
- E-mail: a link to send e-mails directly from the SIGE. (National Coordinators, Project Managers and People Responsible for the CCT).



SIGE - Improvements

- ✓ Inactive Manager: its updating permit was extended in order to allow the updating of the project situation.
- CCT Supervisors: access to the same reports than the Secretary of the CCT.
- Presentation Feature: this feature is used to create the presentations of the projects; it was created taking as a base the critical stages and the physical objectives.



SIGE – Aspect of its Usage

- Progress has been made in relation to the knowledge of the system by the managers.
- Progress has been made in relation to the use of the tool as an information instrument.
- Progress was made regarding the utilization of this tool as an instrument for information exchange among binational project managers.
- There has not been progress regarding the use of the tool as an instrument for shared management.



Future Challenges

- To promote a progressive change in the follow-up process monitoring of the projects aimed at the search of results and the short-term implementation.
- The SIGE must be used as an appropriate tool in a higher degree to support the decision-making process and the overcoming of critical stages.
- Coordination of actions among the interested parties to identify obstacles that are specific to the implementation and their solution.
