WHAT IS THE FOCEM (in Spanish)?

It is the Structural Convergence Fund for MERCOSUR

It is approved through Decision CMC N° 45/04 and completed through Decisions 18/05 and 24/05

These funds are destined to finance:

- programs to promote structural convergence
- the development of competitiveness
- the promotion of social cohesion, in particular regarding minor economies and less-developed regions
- the support to fund the institutional structure and the strengthening of the integration process

INTEGRATION OF THE FOCEM

With annual contributions by the States Parties carried out half-yearly

It can receive contributions from:

- √ third countries
- ✓ institutions
- √international organizations

PERCENTAGE OF INTEGRATION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE FOCEM

>Argentina: 27%

≻Brazil: 70%

➤ Paraguay: 1%

➤ Uruguay: 2%

* The implementation will be gradual: 1st year: 50%, 2nd

year: 75%, and 3rd year: 100%

DISTRIBUTION OF RESOURCES

The Resources of the FOCEM aimed at the financing of the projects in Programs I, II and III will be distributed among the States Parties, according to the following percentages:

- ➤ Projects presented by Paraguay: 48%
- ➤ Projects presented by Uruguay: 32%
- ➤ Projects presented by Argentina: 10%
- ➤ Projects presented by Brazil: 10%

NATIONAL COMPENSATIONS OF THE FOCEM FUNDS

- ➤ The States Parties must participate in the financing of the projects approved in their favor, with their own equivalent funds, at least 15% of the total value of such projects.
- The States Parties must contribute, at least, 15% of the eligible expenses of the projects for which they are beneficiaries; they will also be responsible for all the non-eligible expenses.

PRIORITY PURPOSES OF THE FOCEM CONTRIBUTIONS

- ✓ During the first four years, resources will be mainly aimed at Program I and, in particular, at increasing physical infrastructure in the States Parties in order to facilitate the integration process.
- ✓ During that period, up to 0.5% of the resources of the Fund may be granted to Program IV.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS OF THE PROJECTS

They must meet, simultaneously, the following conditions:

- They must be proposed and executed under the public sector responsibility of one or more States Parties, according to what was stated in the Regulations
- They must be adapted to one of the Programs defined in the Regulations
- They must have eligible expenses as well as noneligible expenses of U\$S500,000, or a higher amount, except in the case of the Projects presented within the framework of Program IV

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS OF THE PROJECTS (cont.)

(cont.):

All documentation required must be handed in

 They must have a socio-economic internal rate of return higher than the minimum social rate of return for Programs I and II, except for the projects related to drinking water and drains.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS OF THE PROJECTS (cont.)

✓ The FOCEM projects cannot substitute other projects under execution or public structural expenses or correlative ones that belong to the State Party and that are granted to the final beneficiaries of the project.

INSTITUTIONAL ORGANIZATION

WHICH FUNCTIONS DOES THE DIRECTOR OF THE SM PERFORM IN RELATION TO THE FOCEM?

√The director must perform all the activities related to the administration, management and operation of the FOCEM, including its legal representation.

HOW ARE AGREEMENTS LEGALLY IMPLEMENTED FOR THE USE OF THE FUNDS?

√Through "legal instruments" called COF
(Financing Agreement).

IN WHICH CASES IS IT POSSIBLE TO LOSE APPROVED FINANCING?

If during a twelve-month period (as of the moment the first disbursement has come into effect), the beneficiary State has not requested another disbursement, or if it has not checked that the project is being executed.
