

Special Session on the Incorporation of the Northeastern and Central-Western territories of Brazil into one of the Integration and Development Hubs

NOTES OF THE MEETING

On September 27, 2012, the city of Lima, Peru, hosted a special session on the incorporation of the northeastern and central-western territories of Brazil into one of the Integration and Development Hubs. This work session was held within the framework of the Meeting of the Executive Technical Group (GTE) on the Integration Priority Project Agenda (API) Continuous Monitoring System (CMS), which was attended by the delegations of Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, Suriname and Uruguay, as well as by representatives from the General Secretariat of UNASUR and from IIRSA Technical Coordination Committee.

The National Coordination of Brazil presented an alternative for incorporating the above-mentioned territories into the Amazon Hub, thus expanding the area of influence of this Hub to the east and to the south over territories currently covered by the Peru-Brazil-Bolivia Hub. The presentation is attached as Annex 1.

Subsequently, the delegations agreed to the following:

- The conceptual design of the expanded Amazon Hub will be submitted to the COSIPLAN Coordinating Committee for its approval on November 15, 2012.
- In the Work Plan 2013, within the framework of the GTE meetings on the Project Portfolio update, the work agenda of the GTE on the Amazon Hub will include the application of the Indicative Territorial Planning Methodology with the purpose of creating new Project Groups and analyzing any possible reengineering of the existing ones.
